The subject /person submitting the data must be over 18 years of age. The data being processed are: name and surname, date/ place of birth, residence, tax code, landline or mobile telephone numbers, e-mail address & academic history.

PURPOSE: The personal data you provide are processed for purposes of: A) Contracts/registrations for the services and/or products provided by FIDI and fulfill the request of the interested party to purchase a service; B) Fulfill and implement the tax obligations deriving from educational services; C) Respond to requests for assistance or information, which we will receive by e-mail or telephone. We inform you that phone calls will not be recorded. Fulfill the obligations established by law, regulation, community legislation or by an order of the Authority. Acceptance of provisions of personal data for points A to D are mandatory and in their absence we will not be able to provide our services.

METHODS OF DATA STORAGE. The treatment will be carried out in an automated, electronic and/or manual form, in compliance with the provisions of art. 32 of the GDPR 2016/679 by persons specifically appointed and in compliance with the provisions of art. 29 GDPR 2016/679. In compliance with the principles of lawfulness, purpose limitation and data minimization, your personal data will be kept for the period of time necessary to achieve the purposes for which they are collected and processed up to the terms of the law or 10 years from the termination of the relationship in the case of administrative data.

The data storage does not adopt any automated decision-making process, including profiling, pursuant to article 22, paragraphs 1 and 4, of EU Regulation no. 679/2016. Transfer of personal data The data processed directly by the Data Controller will not be transferred to third parties or to countries outside the EU. RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTY. As an interested party in the processing of personal data, you can exercise the rights provided for by the aforementioned EU Regulation 679/2016 and, in particular: 1) Receive confirmation of the existence of the data and access their content
